THE INFLUENCE OF NORDIC WALKING ON HEALTH OF STUDENTS

Currently, among the students enrolled in higher education, the percentage of almost healthy every year decreases, and the percentage of students with chronic and

acquired diseases increases. To improve the health of students who have restrictions in the load, you can use Nordic walking in physical education classes. This article reveals the positive dynamics of colds and viral diseases in students of the St. Petersburg humanitarian University of trade unions (SPbGUP), for health reasons assigned to the preparatory and special medical groups, from practicing Nordic walking. For students of these medical groups teachers of the Department of physical education SPbGUP developed a program of physical education classes using Nordic walking. The program was tested for 3 years of students' training in SPbGUP. It was attended by 120 students. As a result of testing the developed program for Nordic walking, we can talk about strengthening the immune system and reducing the number of colds and viral diseases. These data confirm the analysis of training logs of physical training sessions and the results of questionnaire.

SUBJECTIVE PERCEPTIONS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN MARRIAGE, THE FUNCTIONS OF THE MODERN FAMILY

The work is devoted to the study of the features of the modern family. The aim of the study is to identify and analyze the subjective perceptions of married young people about the functions of the family. At the first stage, the method of research was a qualitative slightly structured interview which allowed to reveal the real ideas of respondents about the functions of the modern family. According to the results of a qualitative analysis of a number of interviews, a questionnaire "Functional features of the modern family" was compiled, filled in by 104 respondents. Using the methods of mathematical statistics (factor analysis by the principal components method, Kronbach's alpha coefficient), the reduction of the questionnaire and the allocation of scales were carried out. The results indicate high reliability (consistency) of the proposed scales of the questionnaire and its good discriminative ability. The questionnaire can be useful in the work of family consultations to identify differences in the spouses' ideas about the functions of the real and ideal family.

THE ROLE OF ATTACHMENT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF CREATIVE ABILITIES OF STUDENTS OF ART COLLEGE

The article presents the results of a study of the role of attachment to close people in the development of creative abilities of students of art college (n = 62). The "Questionnaire of Attachment to Close People" by Sabelnikova and Kashirsky based on ECR by Brennan, Cark and Shaver, and the battery of tests for diagnosing the creative abilities (F. Williams modified by E.E. Tunik). It was established that the anxiety about relations with loved ones is associated with low indicators of

originality of creative thinking, verbal abilities, an integral component of creative thinking, and the ability to understand complex ideas. The paper concretizes the position of the theory of J. Bowlby on the influence of the quality of attachment to other people on the development of personality in relation to the creative abilities of students.

MENTAL REPRESENTATION OF DIFFICULT LIFE SITUATIONS AS A RESOURCE OF PROTECTIVE AND COPING ACTIVITY OF ADULTS

The article presents the results of a study of the mental representation of a difficult life situation, its contribution to protective and coping activity (coping behavior, mechanisms of psychological protection). Various factors of subjective assessment of the situation are described. It is said that in the works of different authors there are similar characteristics of difficult life situations. The article presents the results of an empirical study (n=169, M=25.4), which found that respondents prefer to use coping strategies: problem-solving Planning, self-Control, Search for social support, and psychological defense mechanisms: Compensation, Denial, Repression, and Reactive formations. Difficult life situations are associated with work, study, relationships with others, close people. Based on the correlation analysis, it is concluded that mental representation affects protective and coping activity in difficult life situations.
